| Code | Description | Comments/Usage Instructions | Statute/Rule |
|------|-----------------------------------|--|----------------------|
| 4701 | Detention and Preliminary Hearing | In Pretrial Detention: Use when scheduling BOTH the Detention Hearing and Preliminary Hearing to be held in the same hearing. | 5-301 and 5-302 NMRA |
| 4510 | Detention Hearing | In Pretrial Detention: Use when scheduling ONLY a Pretrial Detention Hearing to address Conditions of Release. | 5-301 and 5-401 NMRA |
| 4002 | First Appearance | Use when no First Appearance was held in the Magistrate/Metropolitan Court and MUST be held at District Court. | 5-301 and 5-303 NMRA |
| 4527 | Motion Hearing | Use when a party makes an oral or written request (motion) before, during or after a trial. The purpose of the hearing is to ask the judge to issue a ruling or order on the motion. | 5-601 NMRA |
| 4540 | Preliminary Hearing | In Pretrial Detention: Use when holding ONLY a preliminary hearing in a Pretrial Detention case. | 5-302 NMRA |
| 4541 | Presentment Hearing | Use when the responsible party has failed to submit a proposed order to the court or when the parties cannot agree on the language in a proposed order. | |
