This Quick Guide is only a summary of newly created event codes. Please refer to Odyssey for additional codes.

| Code | Description | Usage Notes |

| 9046 | MTN: To Amend/Modify Child Support (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Amend/Modify Child Support in a PENDING case. |
| 9047 | MTN: To Review/Arrears and Update Judgment (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Review/Arrears and Update Judgment in a PENDING case. |
| 9048 | MTN: For Order to Show Cause (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion for Order to Show Cause in a PENDING case. |
| 9049 | MTN: To Intervene (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Intervene in a PENDING case. Verify CSED was added as a party. Based on the Motion enter a cause of action if necessary. See SOP |
| 9050 | MTN: to Reconsider/Review (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Reconsider/Review in a PENDING case. |
| 9051 | MTN: to Reinstate (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Reinstate in CLOSED case. |
| 9052 | MTN: Motion (CSED) | Use when CSED files a generic Motion in a PENDING case. |
| 9053 | RPN: Motion for Order to Show Cause (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion for Order to Show Cause in a CLOSED case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened. |
| 9054 | RPN: Motion to Amend/Modify Child Support (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Amend/Modify Child Support in a CLOSED case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened. |

| 9055 | RPN: Motion to Intervene (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Intervene in a CLOSED case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened |
| 9056 | RPN: Motion to Review Arrears and Update Judgment (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion to Review Arrears and Update Judgment in a CLOSED case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened. |
| 9057 | RPN: Motion/Petition to Reopen (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Motion /Petition to Reopen in a CLOSED case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened |
| 9058 | RPN: Order to Reopen (CSED) | Use when the judge files and Order to reopen the case. Enter a new cause of action. Verify the case status updated to reopened. |
| 9059 | CLS: Dismiss by Party (CSED) | Use when CSED files a Dismiss by Party and the action will close the case. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9060 | CLS: Judgment/Default (CSED) | Use when a default judgment is granted to CSED. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9061 | CLS: Judgment/Foreign (CSED) | Use when a foreign judgment is granted on behalf of CSED. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9062 | CLS: Petition/Motion Withdrawn (CSED) | Use when the petition/motion to withdraw, filed by CSED, is granted. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9063 | CLS: Stipulated Order (CSED) | Use when a stipulated order is granted on behalf of CSED. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9064 | ORD: Stipulated (CSED) | Use when a stipulated order is filed on behalf of CSED. |
| 9065 | ORD: To Show Cause (CSED) | Use when an order to show cause is granted for CSED. |

| 9066 | ORD: to Intervene (CSED) | Use when the judge grants the Motion for CSED to intervene on a PENDING case. |
| 9067 | ORD: Denying Intervention (CSED) | Use when the judge denies the Motion for CSED to intervene in a PENDING Case. |
| 9068 | CLS: Order Denying Intervention (CSED) | Use when the judge denies the Motion for CSED to intervene on a reopened case. Verify the case status updated to closed. |
| 9069 | CLS: Order Approving Hearing Officer Report (CSED) | Use when the order approving the hearing officers report closes the case. |
| 9070 | CLS: Order to Close (CSED) | Use when CSED is no longer pursuing action in the case/ closing their CSED case. |
| 9071 | CLS: Dismissal by Lack of Prosecution (CSED) | Use when an Order of Dismissal for Lack of Prosecution is filed. |
