Attention court staff who review and annotate filings in File & Serve,

New development for the text stamps, signature stamps, and insert text has been deployed today in the Production File & Serve Review Tool.

Now when you select a manual text stamp or signature stamp to apply to the document, you can place your cursor in the spot where you want to apply the stamp and click once. Then click the name of the stamp again to deselect it (or press the esc key on your keyboard). Once the stamp name is deselected you can then use your cursor to move the stamp as needed or delete it. If you do not deselect the stamp name (or click the esc key), your cursor will continue to apply the stamp with each click.



The Insert Text feature will also allow you to place your text in the exact spot you choose. To deselect the Insert Text feature, just click the esc key on your keyboard.



The text stamps, signature stamps, and inserted text will now hold their positions once the filing is transmitted to Odyssey, however, resizing of the stamps is still not holding the new size during the accept/transmission process.
