17 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 24-
18 101 and 17A-005 NMRA is APPROVED;

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendment of 24-
20 101 shall be **effective immediately for the 2016 elections**; and


