11   **ORDER**

13           WHEREAS, this matter having come on for consideration by the Court upon  
14 recommendation to provide training to district, metropolitan, and magistrate  
15 judges, as applicable, with regard to new case processing requirements for  
16 foreclosure cases and consumer debt collection cases adopted by this Court on  
17 August 2, 2021. *See* Order No. 21-8500-018; Order No. 21-8300-004, and Order  
18 21-8500-005; *see also* new Rules 1-003.3 and 1-054.2 NMRA and new Forms 4-  
19 227, 4-712, 4-805.1, and 4-805.2 NMRA;

20           WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, and this Court having considered the  
21 recommendation and being sufficiently advised; Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil,  
22 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, and Justice Julie J. Vargas  
23 concurring;

24           NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the District and Metropolitan  
25 Judges Association (DMJA) shall provide applicable training to all district,

1 metropolitan, and magistrate judges with regard to the new case processing  
2 requirements for foreclosure and consumer debt collection cases;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all district, metropolitan, and magistrate  
4 judges who preside over foreclosure or consumer debt collection cases shall attend  
5 one of the trainings provided by DMJA on Tuesday, August 24, 2021, at 8:00 a.m.;  
6 Wednesday, August 25, 2021, at noon; or Thursday, August 26, 2021, at noon;


7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DMJA shall provide all district,  
8 metropolitan, and magistrate judges with instructions for selecting and attending  
9 one of the mandatory training sessions required by this order; and

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chief Justice may grant an excusal  
11 from attending the mandatory training sessions in this order upon a showing of  
12 extraordinary circumstances and on the condition that the judge requesting an  
13 excusal receive the required training at an alternate date set at the discretion of  
14 DMJA.

15 IT IS SO ORDERED.
