Description

This course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to respond effectively to an active shooter situation. Topics covered will include identifying and responding to potential violence and/or threats, understanding the characteristics of active shooters, and examples of scenarios and responses.

Goal

The goal of this training is to provide staff with the knowledge, skills, and mindset to effectively respond to an active shooter situation and increase their chances of survival. This training includes learning how to recognize the warning signs of potential violence, developing a plan for what to do in an active shooter situation (Run, Hide, Fight), and give examples of how to react quickly and decisively in order to protect oneself and others. The ultimate goal is to empower individuals to stay safe and potentially save lives in the event of an active shooter incident.

Learning Outcomes

After successful completion of this course, you will be able to:

1. Identify potential warning signs and threats of an active shooter situation.
2. Understand the characteristics of active shooters.
3. Understand how to react quickly and decisively by utilizing the Run, Hide, Fight response plan.
4. Develop an emergency plan for responding to an active shooter situation.
